22.1

1. וְהָאֱלֹהִים - 7x - Mm145 (Gn 22.1; Exod 19.19; 21.13; Qoh 3.14, 15; 1 Chr 28.3; 2 Chr 13.15)
2. נִסָּה - 6x, 4x written with שֵׁא, 2x written with סָה
3. הִנְנִי - 7x in the Torah

22.2

1. וְלֶךְ - 11x - Mm1500 (Gn 22.2;p 27.13; Jdg 18.19; 1 Sam 16.1; 29.7; 2 Sam 14.21; 2 Kgs 6.3; 8.8; 9.1; Ezek 3.1, 11)
2. הַמְרִיגָה - 2x - once fully written and once defectively written - Mm146 (Gn 22.2; 2 Ch 3.1)
3. אָחֵד - 25x - Mm187 (Gn 21.15; 22.2; 26.10; 32.23; 37.9; 48.22; Lev 13.2; Num 16.15; Deut 1.2; 25.5; Jdg 17.5; 1 Sam 9.3; 26.15; 2 Sam 6.20; 7.7; 1 Chr 17.6; 2 Sam 17.22; 1 Kgs 19.2; 22.13; 2 Kgs 6.12; 22.13; Isa 36.9; Ezek 33.30; 45.7; Dan 10.13)

22.3

1. וְאֵת יִצְחָק - once only
2. עֵצִי עֲלֶיהָ - once only

22.4

1. מִרְחֹק - 7x written defectively in the Torah

22.5

1. שָׁבוּ - 5x in the Torah
2. וְנִשְׁוֹבָה - 7x - Mm2714 (Gen 22.5; Num 14.4; 1 Sam 9.5; Jer 46.16; Hos 6.1; Lam 3.40; 5.21)

22.6

1. וַיִּשֶׂם - 84x, 33x of them in the Torah (?) [Mp sub loco - "Weil has combined two notes in the BHS. The first section (פֶּרֶד) which enumerates all occurrence of וַיִּשֶׂם, comes form 1 Chr 18:6. The second section (לֹג מִנְהַ בַּתּוֹרָה), which enumerates all occurrences in the Torah, is a reworded form of the Mp note in L found here."¹

2. על־יִצְחָק - once only

3. הַמֵּאֲכֵלֶת - 3x - Mm1511 (Gen 22.6, 10; Jdg 19.29)

22.7

1. וַיֹּאמֶר - 2x verses which there is in them; 4x with וַיֹּאמֶר - Mm2019 (Gen 22.7; 1 Kgs 20.14)

2. הַנְּנִי - 2x dagesh

22.9

1. וַיִּבֶן שָׁם אֲבָרָהֶם - once only

2. וַיַּעֲקֹד - only once and defectively written

3. וַיִּשָּׂם - 84x and 33x written full in the Torah

22.10

1. וַיִּשְׁלַח אֲבָרָהֶם אֶת־יָדָיו - 4x

2. הַמֵּאֲכֵלֶת - 3x Mm1511 (Gen 22.6, 10; Jdg 19.29)

3. לְשֹׁחַט - 2x, once defective and once full - Mm147 (Gen 22.10; Ezek 40.39)

22.11

1. אֲבָרָהֶם | אֲבָרָהֶם - 4x [Mp sub loco] of a repeated name, and one of 2x [Mm148 (Gen 22.11; 25.19)] in this form.

1.1 "This note is a combination of two separate Mp notes. . . . Four different names are marked in BHS. The occurrences and the names are: Gen 22.11 (Abraham), Gen 46.2 (Jacob), Exod 3.4 (Moses), 1 Sam 3.10 (Samuel). All have *pasēq* except (sic) Exod 3.4 (Moses)."²

1.2 Mynatt points out that the notation is problematic since the doublets occur more than one. - "Name doublets occur in other passages which are not enumerated by this note: Gen 6.9 (Noah), Gen 11:27 (Terah), and 2 Sam 19.5 (Absalom). Two similar lists are found in Ginsburg's *Massorah*. . . ."³

1.3 Mynatt recommends the Mp note in the *Rabbinic Bible*. - ג' שמו' מורכב ופס' - "three occurrences of a repeated name with *pasēq*."⁴

2. הַנְּנִי - 7x in the Torah - [Mp sub loco] - "Perhaps Weil wanted to point out that הַנְּנִי is at issue not

the variant forms of the same word: הַנְּנִי and הִנְנִי. Perhaps the problem is in the absence of an Mm list giving the occurrences."⁵

22.12

1. וְאֶל־תַּעֲשׂ - 2x - Mm2687 (Gen 22.12; Jer 39.12)
2. יִרְאֵ אֱלֹהִים - x4 - Mm3450 (Gen 22.12; Job 1.8; 2.3; Qoh 7.18; and once . . . Job 1.1)
3. אֶתָּה - 26x from above - i.e. accent placed on the penultima syllable.
4. חֲשַׁכְתָּ - 3x
5. אַתָּ - 26x verses with אַת and with one word between them.
6. בְּזִמְנוֹי - 57x and all Psalms which are alike, except 11x

22.13

1. נֶאֱדָרָה - once only [Mp sub loco] - "There is no apparent error or contradiction in this note. Presumably, Weil intended to make some other kind of observation here."⁶
2. בְּסִבְרָה - once only
3. לְעֵלָה - All the Torah is defective. - אַ גַּזְּ = except 1x - [Nu 28,27, cf. Mp sub loco] - The discussion seems to be that the issue may be the לְ - "There are no occurrences in the Torah of לְעֵלָה (with לְ) spelled *plene*. . . . If the *lāmed* preposition is not at issue, the note in L is in error. This is how Weil understands the note. . . ."⁷

22.14

1. בְּהֵרַ יְהוָה - x3 - Mm149 (Gen 22.14; Isa 30.29; Ps 24.3)
2. יִרְאֵה - 13x - Mm150 (Gen 22.14; Exod 13.7, 7; 23.17; 34.23; Deut 16.4, 16, 16; Jdg 5.8; Isa 60.2; Zech 9.14; Pss 84.8; 90.16)

22.16

1. בִּי נִשְׁבַּעְתִּי נְאֻם־יְהוָה - 2x - Mm2573 (Gen 22.16; Jer 22.5)
2. נְאֻם־יְהוָה - 2x in the Torah - Num 14.28
3. חֲשַׁכְתָּ - 2x

1. וְהִרְבָּה אֲרֵבָה - 3x Mm22 (Gen 3.16; 16.10; 22.17)
2. וְכָחֹל - 2x with similar meaning - Mm3526 (Gen 22.17; Job 29.18)
3. וִירָשׁ - 3x written defectively
4. וִירָשׁ זֶרְעֶךָ - only once - Mm151 (Gen 22.17; with two - 24.60 [Deut 30.7])??
5. ???

22.18

1. גִּוְיִי - all of the Torah full
2. בְּקִלְיִי - all of the occurrences are defective except one which is full.

22.19

1. אֶל־בְּאֵר - once only
